Who can use our Dental Service?

All children: 0–12 years of age.

Young people: 13–17 years of age:

- Dependants of Healthcare/Pensioner Card Holders
- Those eligible under the Child Dental Benefit Schedule (CDBS)

What does it cost?

- Children & Young People 0–17 years of age who are / are dependants of Healthcare/ Pensioner Card Holders → FREE
- Children 0–12 years of age who are not dependants of Healthcare/ Pensioner Card Holders → \$33.50 for a course of general care (\$134 max. per family per year)
- Children & Young people eligible for Child Dental Benefit Schedule (CDBS)
→ Bulk Billed (No-Gap) Treatment up to max. \$1000 over 2 years.
→ Over the \$1000 cap? That's OK – We will complete treatment for FREE
